### Pastoral Transítíon Update

The Session is actively navigating the transition ahead as Brad and Barb retire.

- Plans are in the works for a celebration of their 33 years with us, so mark your calendars for Sunday May 19, immediately following the service in the sanctuary. It will also be available by live stream.
- Session delegated the Administration and Records Team to create and disseminate the job description for our *Transitional* Pastor. That team is working with the Presbytery to get the word out to prospective candidates in a timely manner. Note: this is separate and distinct from the search that will happen for a *Called* Pastor.
- > We are arranging for what is called "pulpit supply," meaning pastors who will lead the services on Sundays after June 9, until the Transitional Pastor joins us.
- We are also arranging for pastoral care to be available after June 9 and until the Transitional Pastor joins us, as all of us will take comfort knowing that the congregation's spiritual needs will be responded to faithfully.
- > Trinity's Mission Study process, the first step in finding a Called Pastor, will be guided by the Transitional Pastor and will begin once that person is in place.

Saying goodbye to Brad and Barb is both sad and difficult. With God's help we look forward to a time of discovery and potential as we imagine together what Trinity can be in the years to come. We hope you will join us in daily prayer for God's blessing on this important work. We will do our best to share information as this process moves forward. 


